Introduction

Pan Masala refers to a balanced mixture of betel leaf with lime, areca nut, clove, cardamom, mint, tobacco and many other ingredients. It is prepared with precise measurements so as to maintain a balance of all ingredients while keeping in mind its taste and human health. Pan Masala acts as a mouth freshener and unlike other Western synthetic pan masala which are made with chemical and petroleum ingredients, the Indian pan masala is considered safer. It is available in hygienic and attractive foil packets (sachets) and tins which are easy to store and carry.

The Indian pan masala market reached a value of US\$ 36.5 Crores in 2016 and is further expected to reach nearly US\$ 90 Crores by 2022. The strong growth of the market can be attributed to a number of factors. As pan masala has been traditionally popular in India, it is consumed by all age groups and social classes in the region. Large population along with rising disposable incomes also provide a huge consumer base for pan masala products. Moreover, convenient packaging, easy availability, competitive marketing by manufacturers as well as the shift from tobacco to tobacco-free products have further fuelled the demand for pan masala globally. Although it has gained prominence in urban households of India, especially among adolescents, its demand is growing faster in rural households.




Various types of pan masala available in the Indian market include pan masala containing tobacco, plain pan masala, flavoured pan masala and others. Pan Masala containing tobacco dominate the market with a share of more than a half of the total market in 2016. It was followed by plain pan masala, flavoured pan masala and others.

There are a number of factors which have influenced the demand for pan masala at the global level. The primary factor is the aggressive advertising done by the manufacturers, often by roping in celebrities to endorse their products. By doing so, manufacturers promote the use of pan masala as a status symbol. Moreover, manufacturers offer pan masala in convenient and attractive packaging, which is priced differently keeping in view different economic backgrounds of the consumers. On the other hand, an increase in the disposable income of the consumers, both in the rural and urban regions, has helped expanding the consumer-base, as their expenditure is oriented towards purchasing Pan Masala. Furthermore, new products introduced with different flavours, and without tobacco, have added to its growing popularity. Owing to these factors, the market is expected to reach a value of around INR 60,198 Crores by 2023.



The global tobacco market witnessed a steady growth in recent years. The major factors driving the growth of the market are the introduction of new product range, huge investments in the R&D, lack of government regulations, etc.

India is the ~ largest tobacco market in the world in terms of tobacco consumption. adition in India for many decades. Presently, the smokeless tobacco is the largest tobacco product category in India. On account of the fact the majority of the Indian tobacco consuming population consumes beedis, snuff and smokeless tobacco, including gutka, khaini and zarda, the tobacco market is majorly held by chewing and beedi tobacco products.



Unlike other countries such as the US, UK and others where the production of cigarettes accounted for more than \sim % of total production of tobacco related products, in India, the tobacco market is majorly controlled by the production of snuffs, guthka and others.

The tobacco market in India is expected to grow at a CAGR of 6.3% over FY 2016 to FY 2020. India, being the second largest producer and third largest exporter of tobacco in the world, benefits significantly from the tobacco market in terms of revenue and employment.







The tobacco demand and consumption is very high in India, which will continue to be the key driver of growth in the market. This will be followed by demand from countries outside of India. Legal cigarettes contribute to the majority of the tax revenue compared to other tobacco products.







Cigarettes constitute the single-largest class of tobacco products offered by industry operators, accounting for a combined 90.5% of revenue in 2017. Manufactured cigarettes are made from dried or cured leaves of the tobacco plant. Cigarettes can be further segmented into whether they are marketed as global or premium brands, or whether they are marketed as discount or local brands. In highly developed and regulated markets such as the United Kingdom and Canada, demand for value cigarettes and roll-your-own tobacco products has increased at the expense of premium cigarettes. However, in certain emerging markets, demand for premium cigarettes has increased, driven primarily by rising disposable income levels and aggressive marketing by industry operators.


